CAREERS

A certified nurse-midwife (CNM) is a licensed healthcare professional specializing in women's reproductive health and childbirth, performing annual exams, providing counseling, and writing prescriptions. As of 2010, CNMs now need a graduate degree in addition to a bachelor of science degree in nursing and licensure.

TIPS

Contrary to popular belief, 94% of all CNM attended births occurred in hospitals (only 2.5% in homes). So be careful not to entertain or eliminate a career based on false or out-of-date information!
